A New Outdoor Adventure Takes Shape in Bedford County

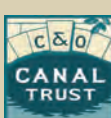
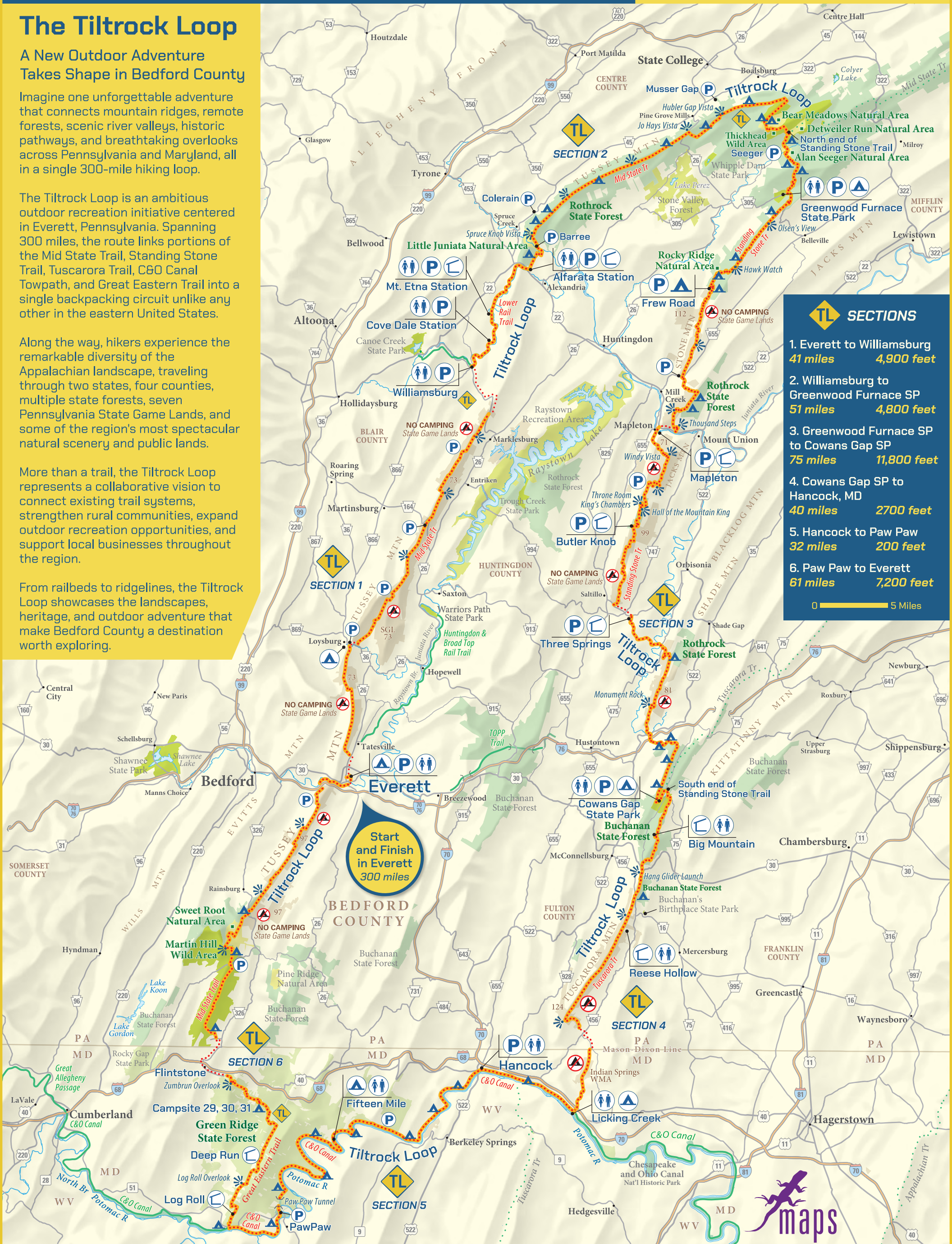
Imagine one unforgettable adventure that connects mountain ridges, remote forests, scenic river valleys, historic pathways, and breathtaking overlooks across Pennsylvania and Maryland, all in a single 300-mile hiking loop.

The Tiltrock Loop is an ambitious outdoor recreation initiative centered in Everett, Pennsylvania. Spanning 300 miles, the route links portions of the Mid State Trail, Standing Stone Trail, Tuscarora Trail, C&O Canal Towpath, and Great Eastern Trail into a single backpacking circuit unlike any other in the eastern United States.

Along the way, hikers experience the remarkable diversity of the Appalachian landscape, traveling through two states, four counties, multiple state forests, seven Pennsylvania State Game Lands, and some of the region's most spectacular natural scenery and public lands.

More than a trail, the Tiltrock Loop represents a collaborative vision to connect existing trail systems, strengthen rural communities, expand outdoor recreation opportunities, and support local businesses throughout the region.

From railbeds to ridgelines, the Tiltrock Loop showcases the landscapes, heritage, and outdoor adventure that make Bedford County a destination worth exploring.
